



Improving the research assessment system

Policy objective

- Objective of the Commission: **facilitate and speed up reforms to research assessment**
- Towards a research assessment system that:
 - Promotes qualitative judgement with peer-review, supported by a more responsible use of quantitative indicators;
 - Considers the **value and impact of a diversity of research outputs**;
 - Incentivizes open collaboration and early knowledge and **data sharing**;
 - Rewards the diversity of tasks of researchers, and supports team science.
- Not a new objective but a new initiative
- Coherence between research and academic assessments is necessary

A European initiative

- An **alliance** of funders, research performing organisations (including universities) and national evaluation agencies, willing to take the lead in reforming the current research assessment system
 - Agreement on **principles** and **actions** between funders and performers;
 - Building on DORA and other declarations;
 - **Committing signatories to act** according to a roadmap for delivery;
 - **Joint ownership** of the initiative by the participating organisations;
 - **Monitoring** of progress.

Next steps

- Finalise the **consultations** and publish a **report**, and organise a **meeting with stakeholders** (December 2021).
- Translate the agreed rationale, principles and actions, into a **draft Memorandum of Understanding**, and introduce a timetable for reforms.
- **Political announcement** of the initiative at an event of the French Presidency on 4 & 5 February 2022.
- **Roll out** the initiative during 2022.

Open Research Europe (ORE)

The open access publishing platform for Horizon 2020 and Horizon Europe beneficiaries

The publishing service



- A **peer-reviewed** publishing platform. ORE is **not a repository**
- **Original** articles i.e. stemming from Horizon 2020-funded research and Horizon Europe
- **All scientific areas** of Horizon 2020 and Horizon Europe covered
- **Immediate open access**, with **content licensed for re-use**
- **Open peer review** (i.e. open reviewer identities, published reviews, post-publication comments)
- Each article has a **dedicated metrics** page
- ‘Super-networked’ and ‘minable’: PIDs, connection to repositories, **open data** and software, interoperable technologies, preservation of content, etc.


Some figures...

220 submissions – 118 published articles – 36 passed peer-review

Authors from 31 different European countries

Top 10 countries for submission:

- Spain: 48
- UK: 47
- Germany: 47
- Italy: 39
- France: 33
- The Netherlands: 26
- Greece: 20
- Belgium: 17
- Austria: 17
- Ireland: 15



The future of ORE

- Beyond March 2024 (end of the current framework contract)
- Establish a vision: current thoughts to expand within the European Commission and beyond i.e. **other framework programmes** (e.g. Health Programme, European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF), etc.) and **other national funders**
- Exploring possibilities in **legal and organizational terms**
- **Sustainability** and long-term service is already being studied

Expanding to national funders?

- An option, if there is commitment from national funders
- During this framework contract: **Case studies** to be carried out in collaboration with interested national funders to explore possibilities for future involvement (**anticipating legal and organisational aspects**)



 - Equipa (13+5 ACC, 100 FCCN)
 - Orçamento (aprox. 15 M€ ACC/ > 20 M€ FCCN)
- Governação
 - GT CRUP (Ciência Aberta)
 - Consórcio EOSC.pt?
- Políticas
 - Política de acesso aberto, dados abertos => Política CA
- Serviços
 - Consolidação de serviços (ex: Repositório de publicações e de dados)
 - Serviços na nuvem vs geridos pela FCCN
