
Shakespeare Translation Memory

Its monthly periodical, *O Vegetariano: Mensário Naturista Ilustrado*, directed by Dr. Amílcar De Sousa and published uninterruptedly between 1909 and 1935, had a community of over 3.500 subscribers. All periodical items, besides other related research and outreach outputs, are indexed in this searchable database.






